Dear President [REDACTED]:

Pursuant to the Arizona Board of Regents Policy 5-401, et.seq. and in accordance with the Arizona Board of Regents Student Code of Conduct, this letter is to inform you that effective immediately, Theta Xi is placed on ***Activities Suspension***.

Activities Suspension has been imposed pending the outcome of this investigation because it has been determined that your organization presents a substantial risk to members of the university community. ***Activities Suspension prohibits hosting, attending, participating, and sponsoring any organizational activities until the final disposition of this case. Club business meetings are the only allowed activities during this suspension.***

On April 14, 2024, at approximately 8:00 PM, the Dean of Students Office received a report of alleged instances of harm (mental, emotional, and physical) inflicted on pledging students by Theta Xi. Such behavior is in violation of the Arizona Board of Regents Student Code of Conduct, pertinent parts of which are stated below:

Code of Conduct/19. Hazing - Engaging in, supporting, promoting, or sponsoring hazing or violating Board or University rules governing hazing.

Code of Conduct/2. Endangering / Threat / Cause Harm - Endangering, threatening, or causing physical harm to any member of the university community or to oneself, causing reasonable apprehension of such harm or engaging in conduct or communications that a reasonable person would interpret as a serious expression of intent to harm.

Code of Conduct/26. Violation of State or Federal Law - Commission of any offense prohibited by state or federal law or local ordinance.

When we meet, I shall answer questions and explain the Student Code of Conduct Disciplinary process. It is expected that Theta Xi fully cooperate with this investigation. Any acts impeding the disciplinary process are prohibited. Any contacts with the alleged victims for purpose of intimidation and retaliation are prohibited and will result in future disciplinary action.

If this directive is violated, Theta Xi may receive more restrictive sanctions, including but not limited to loss of recognition.
