On behalf of Delta Sigma Phi Fraternity, I would like to express our sincere gratitude for your support of the Beta Omega chapter of Delta Sigma Phi at the University of Arizona. The purpose of this letter is to confirm our decision to pause chapter operations until the 2023-24 academic year.

Following our discussion on November 18, 2022, it is clear that the current chapter membership is not meeting headquarters, interfraternity council, or university expectations related to financial management, engagement, or academic performance.

In an effort to provide the best possible fraternal experience, we feel it is necessary to dedicate a staff-led recruitment and training project in late fall and early spring semesters of the next academic year.

Our headquarters will honor any outstanding debts the chapter may owe the interfraternity council (estimated at \$500) and we will release current members who wish to join another fraternity at the University of Arizona.
