The Greek Standards Board has received a complaint against Kappa Alpha for allegedly violating the Social Events Policy

Policy Allegedly Violated

Social Events Policy – Article I. Section D. Subsection B. The presence of alcohol products above 15% alcohol by volume ("ABV") is prohibited on any chapter/organization premises or at any event, except when served by a licensed and insured third-party vendor.

Nature of Complaint:

"On September 21 at 1:13 AM, the Community Director On Call (CDOC) contacted the Manager on Duty (MOD) to report an [REDACTED] female resident who was found in the community bathroom in a state described as "visibly out of it." The student was assisted back to her room. Upon waking, the student was unable to sit up or stand on her own. Other students who were with her informed staff that they had been drinking at Kappa Alpha. Specifically, the student consumed three cans of Truly and shots of vodka. The student was transported, while conscious, to Banner Main for further medical attention.

Kappa Alpha did have a registered event with alcohol on Friday, September 20th, from 10 pm – 1:30 am."

Next Steps:

1. The Greek Standards Board requests a written explanation from Kappa Alpha regarding the incident in question. The explanation is due to the Greek Standards Board email by

2. The hearing for your case is currently scheduled for ______. The Board encourages you to bring persons whom you think would present relevant information regarding this matter. The hearing will take place in room _____ in the student union, across from the CSIL.

- 3. As part of the forthcoming hearing, your chapter has the right to a fair process. Fair process rights are as follows:
 - 1. Right to be notified, in writing, of all charges.
 - 2. Right to present a response, including the calling of witnesses
 - 3. Right to question witnesses

- 4. Right to be accompanied by an advisor for advisory purposes only, but not for representation
- 5. Right to be notified, in writing, of all findings and sanctions imposed
- 6. Right to appeal the decisions
- 4. The Greek Standards Board will then conclude with a decision based on the information presented at the hearing. The Board will inform your chapter on its decision within two days of the hearing.
- 5. If the chapter wishes to appeal the decision of the Board, you are required to do so in writing within ten days of the date on the decision letter.

It is the intention of the Greek Standards Board to investigate all sides of the issue thoroughly, and to reach the most appropriate conclusion. If you have any questions about the process, please do not hesitate to contact me at general me.
