The Greek Standards Board has received a complaint against Sigma Alpha Mu for allegedly violating The University of Arizona Residential Organization Policy.

Policy Allegedly Violated

The University of Arizona Student Organization Residential Facility Recognition Policy, Article III. Neighborhood Feedback Process, Section 2. Neighborhood Complaints, "...Neighbor complaints may also be referred to the Greek Standards Board and/or Dean of Students Office if the conduct alleged in the neighbor complaint potentially violates applicable university policy."

Nature of Complaint:

On Monday, November 4th, [REDACTED] was contacted by University Facility Management and University Real Estate regarding dumpster overflow and excessive trash at the Sigma Alpha Mu property. The attached photos show trash from Thursday, October 31st and Monday, November 4th. There are also reports of broken/smashed appliances leaning against the building that need to be properly disposed of. This has been a recurring issue with the chapter, and as a result they are being referred to Greek Standards Board.

Next Steps:

1. The Greek Standards Board requests a written explanation from Sigma Alpha Mu regarding the incident in question. The explanation is due to the Greek Standards Board email (gsb.chiefjustice@gmail.com) by **Wednesday, November 20th, 2024, at noon.**
2. The hearing for your case is currently scheduled for **5:30 pm on Wednesday, November 20th, 2024.** The Board encourages you to bring persons whom you think would present relevant information regarding this matter. The hearing will take place in room 412 in the student union, across from the CSIL.
3. As part of the forthcoming hearing, your chapter has the right to a fair process. Fair process rights are as follows:
 1. Right to be notified, in writing, of all charges.
 2. Right to present a response, including the calling of witnesses
 3. Right to question witnesses
 4. Right to be accompanied by an advisor for advisory purposes only, but not for representation

5. Right to be notified, in writing, of all findings and sanctions imposed
 6. Right to appeal the decisions
4. The Greek Standards Board will then conclude with a decision based on the information presented at the hearing. The Board will inform your chapter on its decision within two days of the hearing.
 5. If the chapter wishes to appeal the decision of the Board, you are required to do so in writing within ten days of the date on the decision letter.

It is the intention of the Greek Standards Board to investigate all sides of the issue thoroughly, and to reach the most appropriate conclusion. If you have any questions about the process, please do not hesitate to contact me at gsb.chiefjustice@gmail.com.
