Dear President :

The Dean of Students Office has received a referral from UAPD and the Greek Standards Board alleging the involvement of Sigma Chi in violations of the Arizona Board of Regents Student Code of Conduct.

On February 22, 2025, UAPD responded to the Sigma Chi fraternity house reference an intoxicated individual in need of medical attention. UAPD was initially met with avoidance from members. Upon entering the chapter house UAPD noted loud music and alcohol consumption, though no event had been registered. Sigma Chi was referred to the Dean of Students Office for alleged Code of Conduct violations.

Such behavior is in violation of the Arizona Board of Regents Student Code of Conduct, pertinent parts of which are stated below:

Code of Conduct/15. Alcohol - Violation of Board or university rules or applicable laws governing alcohol, including consumption, distribution, unauthorized sale, or possession of alcoholic beverages.

Code of Conduct/22. Interference with UA Activities - Interfering with any university disciplinary process, including but not limited to tampering with physical evidence or inducing a witness to provide false information or to withhold information.

Code of Conduct/4. Other Published Rules - Violation of, or attempt to violate, other rules that may be adopted by Board or by the university.

Code of Conduct/7. Failure to Comply - Failure to comply with the directions of university officials or agents, including law enforcement or security officers, acting in the good faith performance of their duties. This section is not intended to prohibit the lawful assertion of an individual's fifth amendment right against self-incrimination.

Findings of violations of the aforementioned Student Code of Conduct may result in sanctions imposed against you.

Violation of this provision can result in penalties, including, but not limited to, filing of additional charges under the Student Code of Conduct and to loss of recognition.
