The Dean of Students Office has received an official complaint alleging the involvement of Sigma Alpha Mu in violations of the Arizona Board of Regents Student Code of Conduct.

On March 10, 2026, Fraternity & Sorority Programs (FSP) notified the Dean of Student Office that Sigma Alpha Mu submitted paperwork to the FSP office that allegedly included forged signatures. Additionally, Sigma Alpha Mu is currently on University Probation for violations of the Student Code of Conduct occurring in October 2025 and has outstanding/overdue sanctions that were required to be completed by January 30, 2026. Such behavior is in violation of the Arizona Board of Regents Student Code of Conduct, pertinent parts of which are stated below

Such behavior is in violation of the Arizona Board of Regents Student Code of Conduct, pertinent parts of which are stated below:

Code of Conduct/7. Failure to Comply - Failure to comply with the directions of university officials or agents, including law enforcement or security officers, acting in the good faith performance of their duties. This section is not intended to prohibit the lawful assertion of an individual's fifth amendment right against self-incrimination.

Code of Conduct/8. Forgery / Unauthorized Alteration - Forgery, falsification, fabrication, unauthorized alteration, or misuse of campus documents, records, or identification, including, but not limited to, electronic software and records.

Findings of violations of the aforementioned Student Code of Conduct may result in sanctions imposed against you and/or Sigma Alpha Mu.

In order to discuss the allegation pending against the organization, please contact me at wmohr@arizona.edu or [REDACTED] no later than Friday, March 20, 2026, to schedule a meeting with DOS. When we meet, I shall answer questions and explain the Student Code of Conduct Disciplinary process. It is expected that Sigma Alpha Mu will fully cooperate with this investigation. Failure to contact DOS by March 20, 2026, will result in Sigma Alpha Mu being placed on immediate activities suspension.

Any acts impeding the disciplinary process are prohibited. The University's "Student Anti-Retaliation Statement" (<https://policy.arizona.edu/human-resources/nondiscrimination-and-anti-harassment-policy>) prohibits retaliation against those who file complaints or otherwise participate in the disciplinary process. Violation of this provision can result in penalties, including, but not limited to, filing of additional charges under the Student Code of Conduct and loss of recognition.
