Dear President [REDACTED]:

Pursuant to the Arizona Board of Regents Policy 5-401, et.seq. and in accordance with the Arizona Board of Regents Student Code of Conduct, this letter is to inform you that effective immediately, Sigma Phi Epsilon is placed on **Activities Suspension**. *Activities Suspension* has been imposed pending the outcome of this investigation because it has been determined that your organization presents a substantial risk to members of the university community.

***Activities Suspension prohibits hosting, attending, participating, and sponsoring any organizational activities until the final disposition of this case. Club business meetings are the only allowed activities during this suspension. Sigma Phi Epsilon is prohibited from any contact with new members.***

On April 28, 2026, the Dean of Students Office received a report alleging that throughout the fall 2025 semester, Sigma Phi Epsilon subjected new members to hazing. Specifically, the report alleged that new members were subjected to sleep deprivation, forced alcohol consumption, kidnapping, and calisthenics. Additionally, the report referenced illegal drug use by Sigma Phi Epsilon members. The reported conduct is alleged to have created an environment that endangered UA students.

Such behavior is in violation of the Arizona Board of Regents Student Code of Conduct, pertinent parts of which are stated below:

Code of Conduct/15. Alcohol - Violation of Board or university rules or applicable laws governing alcohol, including consumption, distribution, unauthorized sale, or possession of alcoholic beverages.

Code of Conduct/16. Drug - Unauthorized use, sale, possession, or distribution of any controlled substance or illegal drug or possession of drug paraphernalia that would violate the law.

Code of Conduct/17. Off Campus Conduct - Off-campus conduct that a reasonable person would

believe may present a risk or danger to the health, safety or security of the Board or university community or to the safety or security of the Board or university property.

Code of Conduct/19. Hazing - Engaging in, supporting, promoting, or sponsoring hazing or violating Board or University rules governing hazing.

Code of Conduct/2. Endangering / Threat / Cause Harm - Endangering, threatening, or causing physical harm to any member of the university community or to oneself, causing reasonable apprehension of such harm or engaging in conduct or communications that a reasonable person would interpret as a serious expression of intent to harm.

Code of Conduct/4. Other Published Rules - Violation of, or attempt to violate, other rules that may be adopted by Board or by the university.

To discuss the pending allegations against the fraternity, a meeting must be scheduled with the Dean of Students Office. To schedule this meeting, please contact Dr. Whitney Mohr by May 1, 2026. When we meet, I will answer questions and explain the Student Code of Conduct Disciplinary process. It is expected that Sigma Phi Epsilon fully cooperate with this investigation. Any acts impeding the disciplinary process are prohibited. Any contact with the alleged victims for the purpose of intimidation or retaliation is prohibited and will result in disciplinary action.
