Dear President [REDACTED]:

Pursuant to the Arizona Board of Regents Policy 5-401, et.seq. and in accordance with the Arizona Board of Regents Student Code of Conduct, this letter is to inform you that effective immediately, Sigma Tau Gamma is placed on **Activities Suspension**. *Activities Suspension* has been imposed pending the outcome of this investigation because it has been determined that your organization presents a substantial risk to members of the university community.

Activities Suspension prohibits hosting, attending, participating, and sponsoring any organizational activities until the final disposition of this case. Club business meetings are the only allowed activities during this suspension. Sigma Tau Gamma is prohibited from participating in any type of recruitment or new member-related activities.

Reportedly, during the fall 2025 semester, new members of Sigma Tau Gamma fraternity were subjected to hazing. Specifically, new members were forced to consume large quantities of alcohol and live goldfish. Additionally, new members were subjected to screaming, degradation, and threats from active members. Such behavior is in violation of the Arizona Board of Regents Student Code of Conduct, pertinent parts of which are stated below:

Code of Conduct/2. Endangering / Threat / Cause Harm - Endangering, threatening, or causing physical harm to any member of the university community or to oneself, causing reasonable apprehension of such harm or engaging in conduct or communications that a reasonable person would interpret as a serious expression of intent to harm.

Code of Conduct/4. Other Published Rules - Violation of, or attempt to violate, other rules that may be adopted by Board or by the university.

Code of Conduct/15. Alcohol - Violation of Board or university rules or applicable laws governing alcohol, including consumption, distribution, unauthorized sale, or possession of alcoholic beverages.

Code of Conduct/17. Off Campus Conduct - Off-campus conduct that a reasonable person would

believe may present a risk or danger to the health, safety or security of the Board or university community or to the safety or security of the Board or university property.

Code of Conduct/19. Hazing - Engaging in, supporting, promoting, or sponsoring hazing or violating Board or University rules governing hazing.

Code of Conduct/26. Violation of State or Federal Law - Commission of any offense prohibited by state or federal law or local ordinance.

To discuss the allegations pending against the fraternity, you are required to schedule a meeting with the Dean of Students Office. When we meet, I shall answer questions and explain the Student Code of Conduct Disciplinary process. It is expected that Sigma Tau Gamma fully cooperate with this investigation. Any acts impeding the disciplinary process are prohibited. Any contact with the alleged victims for the purpose of intimidation and retaliation is prohibited and will result in future disciplinary action.

Please be advised that it is against university policy to retaliate against anyone involved in the investigation. Should retaliation be alleged, it is a separate and distinct potential policy violation warranting another investigation. If this directive is violated, Sigma Tau Gamma may receive more restrictive sanctions, including, but not limited to, loss of recognition.
