This letter confirms the Greek Standards Board meeting on November 18, 2020 regarding Zeta Beta Tau's alleged violation of the Fraternity & Sorority Social Events Policy & Student Code of Conduct. Based on the testimony presented during the hearing of your case, the Greek Standards Board, after a 4-3 vote, has determined that your chapter is responsible for the violation of **Code of Conduct/4. Other Published Rules**. After a 6-0 vote, the board has determined that your chapter is not responsible for the violation of **Fraternity & Sorority Programs Social Events Policy, Code of Conduct/2. Endangering / Threat / Cause Harm and Code of Conduct/7. Failure to Comply**.

Policy Violated:

Code of Conduct/4. Other Published Rules - Violation of, or attempt to violate, other rules that may be adopted by Board or by the university.

This decision was based on careful consideration of all the information before the Greek Standards Board, which included the fraternity's house camera screenshots presented and sent to the Greek standards board showing people not wearing masks, therefore, not in accordance to CDC, state, and campus regulations. This decision was based on the preponderance of the evidence, meaning whether it was more likely than not that the alleged conduct or behavior occurred.

As a result of this decision, the board has agreed that the following sanction shall be imposed on your chapter.

Zeta Beta Tau is required to:

1. Zeta Beta Tau must pay a fine of \$25 per active member of the chapter for violating Student Code of Conduct.
 - a. If an invoice is needed, please contact amydamron@arizona.edu. Payment is due to the Dean of Students Office (Robert L. Nugent Building) by Friday, December 18, 2020. Make check payable to The University of Arizona.

The board is recommending the following:

1. Close/Block back ally way entrance providing access to 7-eleven through Zeta Beta Tau's parking lot.

2. Appoint a Wild West Security to front gate on 1st street to mitigate foot traffic and prevent access to parking lot in general.
3. Reiterate to live-in members and guests alike that they must wear masks in common areas.
4. Limit guest in the fraternity house, instead of maximizing what is “allowed.”

Zeta Beta Tau has the right to an appeal. A written request must be submitted to DOS-deanofstudents@email.arizona.edu November 25, 2020 at 5:00pm. Your written request must include rationale for the appeal. All appeals will be reviewed by the Dean of Students Office.
