This letter confirms the Greek Standards Board meeting on October 24<sup>th</sup>, 2018 regarding Sigma Tau Gamma's alleged violation of On-Campus events with Alcohol. Based on the testimony presented during the hearing of your case, the Greek Standards Board, after an 8 to 0 vote, has determined that your chapter is responsible for the violation of On-Campus Events with Alcohol.

### Policy Violated

#### **On-Campus Events with Alcohol Section 2. Registration**

G. All events involving alcohol must be registered with the Fraternity and Sorority Programs Office.

This decision was based on careful consideration of all the information before the Greek Standards Board, which included admittance of an unregistered party occurring with Sigma Tau Gamma members on September 1<sup>st</sup> in addition to the presence of the chapter president at the event. This decision was based on the preponderance of the evidence, meaning whether it was more likely than not that the alleged conduct or behavior occurred.

As a result of this decision, the board has agreed that the following sanction shall be imposed on your chapter.

1. Sigma Tau Gamma must send a copy of the amended Bylaws encompassing registered events mentioned by the chapter president at the hearing. The amendments will be due to [gsb.chiefjustice@gmail.com](mailto:gsb.chiefjustice@gmail.com) by **Friday, November 16<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 pm.**
2. Sigma Tau Gamma must have all active members sign attendance sheets at both the Events with Alcohol and ASTP trainings to be held on October 29<sup>th</sup>. Copies of the attendance sheets can be sent to [gsb.chiefjustice@gmail.com](mailto:gsb.chiefjustice@gmail.com) by **Friday, November 2<sup>nd</sup> at 5:00 pm.**

Sigma Tau Gamma has the right to an appeal. A written request must be submitted to [DOS-deanofstudents@email.arizona.edu](mailto:DOS-deanofstudents@email.arizona.edu) November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 5:00pm. Your written request must include rationale for the appeal. All appeals will be reviewed by the Dean of Students Office.
