This letter confirms the Greek Standards Board meeting on August 29th, 2018 regarding Theta Chi's alleged violation of the Student Code of Conduct. Based on the testimony presented during the hearing of your case, the Greek Standards Board, after a 5 to 2 vote, has determined that your chapter is responsible for the violation of the Student Code of Conduct.

Policy Violated

Student Code of Conduct

11. Interfering with or disrupting university or university-sponsored activities, including but not limited to classroom related activities, studying, teaching, research, intellectual or creative endeavor, administration, service or the provision of communication, computing or emergency services.

This decision was based on careful consideration of all the information before the Greek Standards Board, which included admittance of members who disrupted the presentation and that the presenter and the executive board were aware of the disturbance. While it was made clear that the executive board was present and aware of the situation, further action to alleviate the disruption was unsuccessful. This decision was based on the preponderance of the evidence, meaning whether it was more likely than not that the alleged conduct or behavior occurred.

As a result of this decision, the board has agreed that the following sanction shall be imposed on your chapter.

1. Theta Chi must create an outline explaining an action plan for hosting a new presentation of their choice that will be given to the entire chapter. This action plan must name a presentation along with plans for a date, time, and room large enough to accommodate the chapter. This outline will be due on **September 14th, 2018 at 5 p.m.**

Theta Chi has the right to an appeal. A written request must be submitted to deanofstudent@email.arizona.edu by Monday, September 10th, 2018 at 5:00pm. Your written request must include rationale for the appeal. All appeals will be reviewed by the Dean of Students Office.
