This letter confirms the Greek Standards Board meeting on September 23rd, 2020 regarding Sigma Nu's alleged violation of the Student Code of Conduct. Based on the testimony presented during the hearing of your case, the Greek Standards Board after a 9-0 vote, has determined that your chapter is responsible for the violation of Student Code of Conduct/4 Other Published Rules, Code of Conduct/7 Failure to Comply and Code of Conduct/17 Off Campus Conduct. After an 8-1 vote has determined that your chapter is responsible for the violation of Student Code of Conduct/2. Endangering / Threat / Cause Harm.

Policy Violated:

Code of Conduct/2. Endangering / Threat / Cause Harm - Endangering, threatening, or causing physical harm to any member of the university community or to oneself, causing reasonable apprehension of such harm or engaging in conduct or communications that a reasonable person would interpret as a serious expression of intent to harm.

Code of Conduct/4. Other Published Rules - Violation of, or attempt to violate, other rules that may be adopted by Board or by the university.

Code of Conduct/7. Failure to Comply - Failure to comply with the directions of university officials or agents, including law enforcement or security officers, acting in the good faith performance of their duties. This section is not intended to prohibit the lawful assertion of an individual's fifth amendment right against self-incrimination.

Code of Conduct/17. Off Campus Conduct - Off-campus conduct that a reasonable person would believe may present a risk or danger to the health, safety or security of the Board

This decision was based on careful consideration of all the information before the Greek Standards Board, which included the admission that Sigma Nu did in fact have over 15 guests on September 11th, 2020 at their chapter facility where members were not following Covid-19 protocol. This decision was based on the preponderance of the evidence, meaning whether it was more likely than not that the alleged conduct or behavior occurred.

As a result of this decision, the board has agreed that the following sanction shall be imposed on your chapter.

1. Sigma Nu must pay a fine of \$15 per active member of the chapter for violating Student Code of Conduct. If an invoice is needed, please contact amydamron@arizona.edu. Payment is due to the Dean of Students Office (Robert L. Nugent Building) by Friday, October 23rd, 2020. Make check payable to The University of Arizona.

The board has agreed that the following recommendations should be take place.

- Create Covid policy for active and new members to follow inside of the Sigma Nu facility adhering to the CDC guidelines.
- Members must both wear masks & stay 6ft a part as per CDC guidelines. <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/prevent-getting-sick/prevention.html>
- Create Covid-19 Member Agreement enforcing members to understand and agree to abiding to the CDC guidelines and Federal, State, and Province regulations.

Sigma Nu has the right to an appeal. A written request must be submitted to DOS-deanofstudents@email.arizona.edu October 9th, 2020 at 5:00pm. Your written request must include rationale for the appeal. All appeals will be reviewed by the Dean of Students Office.
