This letter confirms the Greek Standards Board meeting on August 29th, 2018 regarding Theta Delta Chi's alleged violation of Standards of Excellence Expectations. Based on the testimony presented during the hearing of your case, the Greek Standards Board, after a 7 to 0 vote, has determined that your chapter is responsible for the violation of Standards of Excellence Expectations.

Policy Violated

Failure to comply with outlines loss of campus privileges expectations in the Standards of Excellence.

This decision was based on careful consideration of all the information before the Greek Standards Board, which included failure to meet deadlines defined by the chapter and CJ Graziano for submitting an action plan, as well as failure to complete the loss of campus privileges expectations in accordance with the Standards of Excellence. This decision was based on the preponderance of the evidence, meaning whether it was more likely than not that the alleged conduct or behavior occurred.

As a result of this decision, the board has agreed that the following sanction shall be imposed on your chapter.

1. Theta Delta Chi must schedule two meetings per month with CJ Graziano to further develop Theta Delta Chi's expectations with Standards of Excellence. Proof of these meetings will be accepted from CJ.
2. After planning the suggested philanthropy event from the hearing, invite and include other chapters on campus to gain Standards of Excellence points. An email including what the philanthropy event will entail and how other chapters will be involved will be due with the announcement and creation of the philanthropy event.

Theta Delta Chi has the right to an appeal. A written request must be submitted to deanofstudent@email.arizona.edu by Monday, September 10th, 2018 at 5:00pm. Your written request must include rationale for the appeal. All appeals will be reviewed by the Dean of Students Office.
