This letter confirms the Greek Standards Board meeting on September 25, 2019 regarding Zeta Psi's alleged violation of INTRAMURAL SPORTS FLAG FOOTBALL RULES. Based on the testimony presented during the hearing of your case, the Greek Standards Board, after a 7-0 vote, has determined that your chapter is responsible for the violation of INTRAMURAL SPORTS FLAG FOOTBALL RULES.

Policy Violated:

Rule 12: Conduct of Players, Coaches, and Other – 3. Unsportsmanlike conduct:

This decision was based on careful consideration of all the information before the Greek Standards Board, which included the admission that members of Zeta Psi conducted themselves in unsportsmanlike manners by participating in violence during the intramural flag football game against Tau Kappa Epsilon Fraternity. This decision was based on the preponderance of the evidence, meaning whether it was more likely than not that the alleged conduct or behavior occurred.

As a result of this decision, the board has agreed that the following sanction shall be imposed on your chapter.

Zeta Psi must:

1. Submit a formal apology to the Intramural Sports Program from the chapter. Proof of submission of this apology is due to gsb.chiefjustice@gmail.com by **Monday, October 7th, 2019 at 5 p.m.**
2. Plan and execute a co-hosted philanthropy event with Tau Kappa Epsilon Fraternity. This event must benefit one or more philanthropic organizations and be noncompetitive in nature. This event is to take place no later than **Friday, October 25th, 2019**. Greater than 50% attendance from each chapter is required at this event and each chapter must share all responsibilities regarding the event or additional sanctions may follow. Proof of this event and chapter attendance in the form of pictures and an attendance list with signatures of members is due to the aforementioned email by **Friday, November 1st, 2019**.

Zeta Psi has the right to an appeal. A written request must be submitted to DOS-deanofstudents@email.arizona.edu October 4, 2019 at 5:00pm. Your written request must include rationale for the appeal. All appeals will be reviewed by the Dean of Students Office.
